THE SCHOOL DAY

The first bell rings at 7:50am. School hours are from 8am until 3:15pm for all students.

GENERAL ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

- Students should plan to arrive each morning by 7:50am.
- The accessible doors for students to enter the building are the front / main doors on Lovers Lane and the back / main doors on Amherst. UP staff will be monitoring all doors each morning beginning at 7:30am.
- Teachers will open their classroom doors at 7:50am when the first bell rings.
- Students arriving before 7:50am will be directed to the gym to sit quietly.
- Students arriving with their parents before 7:50am will wait in the first-floor hallway either in the front foyer or on the window seats as directed by a staff member. All students and parents will be able to go to their grade-level pods and classrooms when the 7:50am bell rings.
- Class begins promptly at 8:00am. Parents should leave at this time to minimize class distractions.

GENERAL DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

- Prior to the start of the school year, parents will notify their student's teacher of their preference for pick up either carpool or other (in-person pick up/walking/biking).
- Parents must use the same plan for pick up every day of the school year.
- Should there be a change on a particular day, a note or email should be sent to your student's teacher that morning indicating the dismissal change.
- Students are expected to leave school each afternoon immediately after being dismissed at 3:15pm.
- Crossing guards are on duty for a reasonable length of time at designated intersections.



RAINY DAY DISMISSAL

- The UP front office will send an email to parents by 2:45pm if they will be following special "rainy day dismissal" procedures.
- Please tell your teacher and child at the beginning of the school year what your rainy day carpool plan is.

EXTENDED SCHOOL DAY

- Extended School Day (ESD) is offered by The Academy for Lifelong Learning (A.L.L.) of HPISD and is available for any UP student.
- Students enrolled in ESD will receive care from the end of the school day at 3:15 until 6:00. The program includes a snack, quiet time for homework, and supervised group play. ESD follows the HPISD calendar.
- Registrations must be received in the A.L.L. office by 4:00pm on Wednesday, August 10th in order to begin the program on the first day of school.


PARKING POLICY

- There should never be any unattended cars parked in the queue lane on Amherst during arrival/dismissal times.
- Parking can be found on the streets surrounding the school, except where prohibited by parking signage or painted yellow "no parking" curbs.
- Please be respectful of our neighbors and do NOT block residential driveways or alleys.
- It is illegal to park within 20 feet of an intersection, including alleys, or within 30 feet of a stop sign. Doing so impedes driver visibility as they approach an intersection and puts pedestrians and students, as well as other drivers, at risk.



CARPOOL INSTRUCTIONS

- Carpool takes place on Amherst in a west to east direction.
- Morning carpool begins at 7:30am. From 7:30am until 7:50am, students dropped off in carpool will enter through the Amherst doors and proceed to the gym. After 7:50am, students proceed to the classroom.
- For afternoon carpool, a queue develops on Amherst and wraps onto Turtle Creek.
- Enter the carpool queue from Amherst at Turtle Creek. If the line is backed up, cars must enter the queue from the NORTH side of Turtle Creek (turning left onto Amherst).
- Do NOT enter the carpool queue from Thackery or driving north from Lovers Lane.
- Please enter at the end of the queue and do not cut in front of other cars in the queue.
- While waiting, do not block any intersections and note that walkers and bikers will be crossing all intersections along the carpool route.
- Drivers will continue to move forward in the carpool queue until they enter the designated drop-off / pick-up area in front of the school on Amherst.
- Once students have safely exited or entered the vehicle, drivers may pull onto Amherst, yielding to street traffic.
- Turn right on Dickens to exit the carpool line.
- Please ensure caretakers and grandparents understand the carpool procedures.
- The front spot in the afternoon carpool line is reserved for the Auction winner.





CAFETERIA INFORMATION

Your child will always find great choices for lunch at our cafeteria run by Ms. Tonia, staffed by our parent volunteers. Various lunch options are available to students. They may bring a sack lunch or choose from hot and cold lunch options.

- Kindergarten and First Grade have pre-set tray lunches with a choice of either hot or cold.
- Second, Third and Fourth Graders are given options on an "a La Carte" basis.
- Parents have the option to limit their child's choices if they wish or set spending limits (via Skyward). If you set a daily spending limit, please be sure to review the cafeteria pricing on the school website to ensure the limit allows for a reasonable lunch to be purchased.
- The menu is available online each month.
- For more information, see the Skyward section below.

EATING LUNCH WITH YOUR STUDENT

Parents are welcome to eat lunch with your child at school during the student's assigned lunch period. They may either purchase cafeteria food with their child or bring in a lunch from outside. There is a table designated for parents and students to eat together. Due to allergy issues and parent permissions, please do not invite another student to sit with you.

PURCHASING LUNCH

While cash is accepted in the cafeteria, most parents elect to have their students purchase food through a cafeteria account. To set up a student's cafeteria account and select account settings, parents may do so through their Skyward Family Access account. To put money into a student's cafeteria account, parents may bring cash/check to the cafeteria or make a payment online through their Skyward Family Access account. Parents are encouraged to speak with Principal Judd if financial assistance is needed to purchase school lunches or supplies.

BIRTHDAY TREAT POLICY

Due to allergy concerns, UP does not allow special birthday treats to be brought to school and shared in the classroom. You are, however, welcome to bring outside food/drinks/treats to your child (not to be shared with other students) in the cafeteria during their lunch.

SKYWARD ACCOUNT FOOD SERVICE PAYMENT DIRECTIONS

LOG IN TO SKYWARD FAMILY ACCESS

- Log in to Skyward (through a computer, not mobile app).
- Click "Food Service" & then "Make a Payment."
- You will be sent to eFunds for Schools, where you can log in with your Skyward user name and password (use lowercase characters only).



EFUNDS FOR SCHOOLS – HOW TO ADD MONEY TO YOUR ACCOUNT

- Add money to your child's account through eFunds for Schools. The average daily lunch price is between \$4.50 and \$6.
- Click "Make a Payment" (First time users will be required to enter payment information).
- Select the student you wish to make a payment for (tabs are in the middle of the screen).
- Follow step-by-step instructions to make a payment.
- Click submit and wait for confirmation.

ENABLE ACCOUNT BALANCE NOTIFICATIONS

You can receive alerts when your student's lunch account balance is running low.

- Under Advisory Services, click on "Low Meal Balance."
- Enter a minimum amount balance (\$10.00 is a recommended amount).
- Enter the replenish amount of your choice.
- Check the "Notice" box to receive email notifications.
- Check the "Auto Replenish" box if you want your account to automatically add more money if the account reaches the minimum balance that you set. (Highly recommended to avoid negative balances)
- Click "Apply Low Meal Balance Settings.
- If payment information is changed (for example a new credit card or different checking account number) you will need to reset low meal balance settings for auto replenish.

UP CAFETERIA NEGATIVE BALANCE POLICY (NEW)

The cafeteria offers the cafeteria account payment option as a convenience to the students and parents and, in turn, asks that parents help support the cafeteria's efforts to keep a balanced budget by keeping their student's cafeteria account balance positive at all times.

- The first time a student's cafeteria account reaches an actual balance of negative \$25, the account may be closed until payment is made or arrangements are made with the Cafeteria Manager.
- The second time a student's cafeteria account reaches an actual balance of negative \$25, the account will be reviewed and may be permanently closed for the remainder of the school year.
- In the case of a closed account, the student will only be allowed to use cash for purchases in the cafeteria.
- Failed payments (ie, bounced or returned payments) will be counted towards determining actual account balances under this policy. Accounts in which repeated failed payments are made are subject to permanent cancellation.



 To help avoid negative account balances, the cafeteria encourages parents to set up their student's cafeteria account so that (1) the parents will receive low balance notifications, and (2) the account will be replenished automatically by a certain amount once the account reaches a negative balance. For these settings to become active, the parent must select them through Skyward Family Access.

CAFETERIA VOLUNTEERS

One of the ways U.P. is able to stretch our money is through parent volunteers. Our cafeteria has very few full-time employees. The daily serving and cashiering is done by parents on a volunteer basis. We are looking for parent volunteers to work one lunch shift per month. This is a great way to get to know other parents, see your child and meet their friends.

COMMUNICATIONS

The Panther News (Weekly Electronic Newsletter)

- This is the primary communication tool for the PTA. The Panther News is sent by email from the UP office on Monday mornings. It will contain information on both school and PTA activities. Please be sure to check The Panther News to ensure you are up-to-date on everything going on at UP.
- Occasionally, UP will send eBlasts with certain timely information.

UP School Website (www.up.hpisd.org)

The UP website is another tool used to provide information to UP families. Here you can find information such as cafeteria menus, the school calendar, PTA event details, student resources, and teachers' classroom websites.

This is where you will purchase tickets to school events such as carnival and auction.
